


# user manual



Lamp, base, 2 screws, user manual. You will need the allen wrench- 5


1. Remove the lamp and the base from the box Always hold the lamp by its thicker element, not by its shade.

This foam is to protect the lamp from scratches during assembly. You should be careful especially with the black version on which any scratches may be more visible




# 2a. Base assembly

- 1. Put the lamp and the base on a clean flat surface as shown in picture no. 1.
- 2. Lay the base on its narrower edge with the cable-notch down, as shown in picture no. 2a





3. Slide the cable into the notch as shown and screw the lamp-post to the base with the two screws.




# 3. Rising the lamp-shade

Just lift the shade. The ratchet will automatically release, then engage and block the shade-arm in the chosen position.




# 4. Switch/Dimmer

- 1. Push to turn on the lamp. Touch for a few seconds to adjust brightness.
- 2. Turn the lampshade arm (max.: 270°) to adjust light-direction.



# 5. Adjusting the height


- 1. Manually unscrew the side-screw.
- 2. Rise or lower the foot as desired.
- 3. Screw the side-screw back. Do not use force turn just enough to block the foot from sliding down.



## 6. In order to decrease the inclination of the shade:

- 1. Slightly rise the shade to disengage the ratchet,
- 2. Hold the ratchet-lever in the "open" position and lower the shade to the desired angle.
- 3. Release the ratchet-lever.

Do not apply pressure, do not hang anything to, and do not yank the horizontal arm.

This may result in losing the right angle it or may tip the lamp over.

The lighting horizontal arm must not be covered with anything.

Only use in a dry place. Avoid high humidity.
